Nexus monARC Final Dissemination Event Celebrating Impact, Collaboration, and Future Pathways

The final dissemination event of the Nexus monARC project, held on 17 December 2025, marked a significant milestone in a journey defined by collaboration, innovation, and shared commitment to advancing water quality monitoring in multi-stressor environments. Hosted at the Museum of History of the National and Kapodistrian University of Athens, the event brought together over 70 researchers, collaborators, and community partners.
